Street Commissioner Sanders would like to work with the Township to fix portions of Pam and Circle. The cost for our labor and supplies would be between \$5,000-\$6,000.00. We don't know what the Township would charge yet. Discussion ensued. Council agreed to go forward with this.

We will be purchasing on-road fuel form Gary Schumaker. It will be cheaper than using the credit card all the time.

The Men's restroom door as been torn from the hinges again. This is the third time this year. A curtain will be put up instead of the door or we close the restroom.

Three house permits and 1 shed permit have been issued. Letters have been issued to a house on case for roosters, the Pub for not mowing and a house on Penney for not mowing.
