The Council of the Village of Millbury met in regular session on the above date at the Millbury Council Chambers with Michael Timmons, Mayor, presiding.

Council Members present: Clapsaddle, Harpel, Mikolajczy, Sanders and K. Schwamberger. Keith Nusbaum, street commissioner was also in attendance. S. Schwamberger was excused.

Motion by Mikolajczy to approve the November 14, 2022, meeting minutes. Seconded by Sanders. Roll Call: all yeas! Motion carried.

Police report:

There were 2 speed citations, 1 repossession and 1 dispute investigation in the village.

Fire Department:

There were 14 EMS and 2 fire calls in the Village of Millbury for the month of November.

Public Input:

Rochelle Bowen from Republic Services attended the meeting to discuss our trash service. We now have a list of people we can call when there is a problem.

Street Commissioner: per Keith Nusbaum, Street Commissioner

Bob Desmond from Poggemeyer attended the meeting to discuss Michelle Dr. He will provide estimates to Council. We will be taking out the bad sections of curb (if broken at top) and repairing them. The whole street will then have a mill and overlay. We will be replacing less than half of the curbs. We will be doing a mill and overlay of all of Abby. Mr. Desmond estimates that this project will be \$200,000.00.

We will be contacting the Township to help crack seal all the streets in the village. We will then hire a company to fog seal all the streets.

We had a discussion on the Veteran's Highway sign. No one know where the sign is. Street Commissioner Nusbaum says that the last he knew, the State of Ohio had it.
