

MILLBURY COUNCIL

May 10, 2021

The Council of the Village of Millbury met in regular session on the above date at the Millbury Fire Hall Michael Timmons, Mayor, presiding.

Council Members present: Clapsaddle, Cowell, Densic, Harpel, Schwamberger and Traver. Keith Nusbaum, Street Commissioner was also in attendance.

Motion by Densic to approve the April 12, 2021 meeting minutes. Seconded by Cowell. Roll Call: all yea! Motion carried.

Police report: sent by Lake Township Police

No report was given.

Fire Department: per Dennis Traver

There were 8 rescues, 1 medical assist and 1 electric wiring equipment problem in the village. The tornado siren worked.

Public Input:

Street Commissioner: per Keith Nusbaum, Street Commissioner

Mr. Nusbaum reported that people have been driving through the park. In order stop this behavior, cement blocks have been placed at the entrance to the park so they can not drive through there.

Zoning Commissioner: by Jeff Mraovich

There was one fence permit, 1 shed and 1 pool permit in the village. He is currently fielding more phone calls. He also called Scott from Republic about trash that has not been picked up in the village. We also discussed a new ordinance concerning the number of cats and dogs residents are able to have in the village. He will call other municipalities for copies of their ordinances.

Much discussion ensued concerning issuing permits for roofing, windows and siding as a possible revenue stream for the village.

Councilmen Cowell and Clapsaddle will meet with Mr. Mraovich to start updating the zoning book which has not been updated since 1995.

Motion by Densic to pay the bills, issue the warrants, review, and approve the financial reports. Second by Harpel. Roll Call: All yea! Motion carried.

Committee Reports:

Councilman Densic did not attend the Storm Water coalition meeting.

Lake Township Police will position a patrol on Southpointe in order to address the speeding situation on that street.

Old Business:

Councilman Densic discussed the pipeline project on the corner of Bradner and Woody Dr. Miller Pipeline (contracted by Columbia gas) still has not come out and finished the project (fixed the road, leveled the dirt, spread grass seed etc.). Clerk Densic will send Miller Pipeline an invoice for the work the village has completed.
