

MILLBURY COUNCIL

September 12, 2022

The Council of the Village of Millbury met in regular session on the above date at the Millbury Council Chambers with Michael Timmons, Mayor, presiding.

Council Members present: S. Schwamberger, Mikolajczy, Sanders and K. Schwamberger. Keith Nusbaum, street commissioner was also in attendance. Motion by Sanders to excuse Councilman Clapsaddle from tonight's council meeting. Seconded by Mikolajzy. Roll Call: All ye! Motion carried.

Motion by Mikolajczy to approve the August 8, 2022 meeting minutes. Seconded by Sanders. Roll Call: all yeas! Motion carried.

Police report:

There was one disorderly conduct, 2 citations for speed, one theft and one property dispute in the village for the month of August.

Fire Department:

There were 15 EMS and 2 fire calls in the Village of Millbury for the months of July and August.

Halloween will be Monday, October 31, 2022 in the village this year from 6:00 – 7:30 pm.

Mayor Timmons and Chief Hummer discussed the village and township working together and borrowing equipment, not renting equipment from each other, as needed.

Public Input:

Street Commissioner Nusbaum spoke about flags being stolen and how difficult it is to buy them.

Street Commissioner Nusbaum received an application from Mark Spitler of Millbury. The personnel committee will be interviewing him.

Joe Fuller hasn't worked in about three weeks. He is on medical leave.

S.C. Nusbaum will be leaving for Florida after Thanksgiving. The question we have to ask is if we will have enough snowplow drivers?

There were 2 driveway, 1 sewer and one shed permit issued in the village. All the letters sent for not mowing grass have been taken care of. There is a property dispute between neighbors on Main St. Discussion ensued. Mr. Mraovich will issue a fence permit to the one neighbor and if the fence is placed wrong, the fence will have to be moved.
